Fabric Requirements

2³/4 yards Breeze-C4843 Noir 1 yard Breeze-C4843 Turquoise (includes binding) ³/4 yard Breeze-C4843 Lime ¹/3 yard Breeze-C4843 Yellow ¹/3 yard Breeze-C4843 Green ¹/3 yard Breeze-C4843 Blue ¹/3 yard Breeze-C4843 Red ¹/3 yard Breeze-C4843 Orange ¹/4 yard Soho-White ³/₂ yards Breeze-C4843 Lime (backing)

Other supplies:

62" x 77" batting 16"-18" square ruler Starch or starch alternative

Cutting

From Breeze-C4843 Noir:

- Cut one 3¹/2" x width-of-fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut twelve 3¹/2" squares.
- Cut seven $2^{"} \times WOF$ strips. Sub-cut forty-eight $2^{"} \times 5^{3}/4^{"}$ strips.
- Cut eight 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty-eight 2" x 7" strips.
- Cut ten 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty-eight 2" x 8¹/4" strips.
- Cut three 4¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-four 4¹/₂" squares. Cut each squares once diagonally to make forty-eight of Triangle B.
- Cut seven $3^{3}/4^{"}$ x WOF strips for the outer border.

From Breeze-C4843 Turquoise:

- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-four 2" x 7" strips.
- Cut six $1^{1}/4^{"}$ x WOF strips for the inner border.
- Cut seven $2^{1/2^{\parallel}} \times WOF$ strips for the binding.

From Breeze-C4843 Lime:

• Cut twelve $2^{"} \times WOF$ strips. Sub-cut forty-eight $2^{"} \times 9^{1}/2^{"}$ strips.

From Breeze-C4843 Yellow:

• Cut five $2^{"} \times WOF$ strips. Sub-cut twenty-four $2^{"} \times 8^{1/4"}$ strips.

From Breeze-C4843 Green:

• Cut five $2^{"} \times WOF$ strips. Sub-cut twenty-four $2^{"} \times 8^{1/4"}$ strips.

From Breeze-C4843 Blue:

• Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-four $2^{"} \times 5^{3/4"}$ strips.

From Breeze-C4843 Red:

• Cut four $2^{"}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-four $2^{"}$ x $5^{3}/4^{"}$ strips.

From Breeze-C4843 Orange:

• Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-four 2" x 7" strips.

From Soho-White:

• Cut two 3¹/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-four 3¹/4" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to create forty-eight of Triangle A.

Block Construction

All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. When trimming blocks, use a square ruler, lining up a diagonal ruler guideline with the center of the unit being trimmed and the ruler edge with the sewn strip. Note that both blocks are constructed the same, using different colors, so only one block will be illustrated.

- Sew a Soho-White Triangle A to each side of a 3¹/2" C4843 Noir square. Make a total of six and label as Block One. Square each block to 4³/4".
- Sew a Soho-White Triangle A to each side of a 3¹/2" C4843 Noir square. Make a total of six and label as Block Two. Square each block to 4³/4". (*figure 1*)



3. Center and sew a $2" \times 5^{3}/4"$ C4843 Blue strip to each side of Block One. Trim the excess fabric, leaving $^{1}/_{4"}$ seam allowance. Repeat on all six of Block One.



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4. Center and sew a 2" x 5³/4" C4843 Red strip to each side of Block Two. Trim the excess fabric leaving ¹/4" seam allowance. Repeat on all six of Block Two. (figure 2)

5. Center and sew a 2" x 5³/4" C4843 Noir strip to each side of Block One and Block Two. Trim excess fabric. Repeat on all six of each block. (figure 3)



- 6. Center and sew a 2" x 7" C4843 Turquoise strip to each side of Block One. Trim the excess fabric. Repeat on all six of Block One.
- 7. Center and sew a 2" x 7" C4843 Orange strip to each side of Block Two. Trim the excess fabric. Repeat on all six of Block Two. (figure 4)





8. Center and sew a 2" x 7" C4843 Noir strip to each side of Block One and Block Two. Trim the excess fabric. Repeat on all six of Block One and of Block Two. (figure 5)



- 9. Center and sew a 2" x 8¹/4" Green strip to each side of Block One. Trim the excess fabric. Repeat on all six of Block One.
- 10. Center and sew a 2" x 81/4" Yellow strip to each side of Block Two. Trim the excess fabric. Repeat on all six of Block Two. (figure 6)



11. Center and sew a 2" x 8¹/4" Noir strip to each side of Blocks One and Two. Trim the excess fabric. Repeat on all six of each block. (figure 7)



12. Center and sew a 2" x 9¹/2" Lime strip to each side of Block One and Block Two. Trim the excess fabric. Repeat on all six of each block. (figure 8)





13. Center and sew a Noir Triangle B to all corners of both Block One and the Block Two. Make six of each color. Trim all blocks to 15¹/2" square. (*figure 9*)

14. Spray the sides of all blocks with starch to prevent stretching of the bias edges.

Quilt Top Assembly

- 15. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for color orientation and placement. Lay out the blocks alternately in four rows of three blocks each. Matching adjacent seams, sew the blocks together in each row. Press seams to one side, alternating direction for adjacent rows.
- 16. Sew the rows together, matching adjacent seams. Press.
- 17. Sew the six 1¹/4" x WOF C4843 Turquoise strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the quilt from length. From the pieced strip, cut two inner borders the measured length. Sew one border to each side of the quilt top.
- Measure the quilt width. From the 1¹/4" C4843 Turquoise pieced strip, cut two inner borders the measured width. Sew one border to the top and the other to the bottom of quilt top.
- 19. Repeat steps 17 and 18 using the seven $3^{3/4^{"}}$ x WOF C4843 Noir strips for the outer borders.

Finishing

- 20. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.
- 21. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- 22. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
