## Check it Out

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage.

### 1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (64) 2-1/2" squares Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders

Fabric B - Cut (6) 2-1/2" (binding) Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (66) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders

Strip Pack - From each of 15 strips, cut (3) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" and (5) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces From each of 9 strips, cut (2) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" and (6) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

Note: Prints in **Strip Pack** pack may vary from color quilt image. Discard 3 lightest 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces cut from **Strip Pack**.

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch a 2-1/2" Fabric A square to end of a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Strip Pack piece. Make a total of 64 Unit 1 (2-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).

- 2. Stitch a 2-1/2" Fabric B square to end of a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Strip Pack piece. Make a total of 62 Unit 2 (2-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).

- 3. Stitch a 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Strip Pack piece between 2 Unit 1. Stitch together lengthwise. Make a total of 32 Block 1 (6-1/2" square unfinished).



4. Stitch a 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Strip Pack piece between 2 Unit 2. Stitch together lengthwise. Make a total of 31 Block 2 (6-1/2" square unfinished).

- Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) or Alternate Quilt Layout for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- Arrange blocks in 9 rows of 7 blocks each.
   Stitch blocks into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (42-1/2"x 54-1/2" unfinished).
- 7. Stitch **Fabric A** 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric A** 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- Stitch Fabric C 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric B 2-1/2" squares to both ends of each Fabric C 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders. Add to top and bottom of quilt.
- The quilt measures approximately
   48-1/2" x 60-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing
   (Fabric D) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 10. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric B) and enjoy!!
