
Crate of Pineapples

Featuring 5 Karat and 10 Karat Mini-Gems or Mini-Jewels Packs Table Runner Quilt: 29 3/4" x 62 3/4" Requires:

4 - 5 Karat Mini Border (A): 5/8 yard*
Binding (B): 1/2 yard Backing: 2 1/8 yards
*Border fabric is also used for piecing - should
coordinate with background pack color.

Crate of Pineapples

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

NOTE ABOUT 5 KARAT PACKS:

If you have 3 identical 5 Karat Mini Packs, separate into 18 squares for the crowns and 40 for the pineapples then cut as directed below.

1. Cut the following for Table Runner:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (2) 5" squares [then cut in half diagonally for 4 triangles] and (1) 3" x 30-1/4" border Cut (3) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 58-1/4" borders Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (1) 3" x 30-1/4" border

Fabric B - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric C: (2) 5 Karat Mini packs (pineapple)

Cut (8) 5" squares in half diagonally //
for 16 triangles

Trim 32 squares to 4-5/8" square

Fabric D: (1) 5 Karat Mini pack (crown)

Cut (10) 5" squares in half diagonally for 20 triangles
Trim 8 squares to 4-5/8" square

Fabric E: (1) 5 Karat Mini pack (background)

Cut (16) 5" squares in half diagonally for 32 triangles

Trim 8 squares to 4-5/8" square

Note: Prints in pre-cut packs may vary from color quilt image.

2. Piecing Order for Table Runner:

- Re-label Fabric A 5" triangles as Fabric E.
- 2. Sew Fabrics C and E 5" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 16 Unit 1 (4-5/8" square unfinished). In the same

manner, make 20 Unit 2 with Fabrics D and E 5" triangles.

- Referring to Block Layout, arrange Fabrics
 D, and E 4-5/8" squares and Units 1 and 2 in 7 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together.
 Make a total of 4 blocks (12-7/8" x 29-3/8" unfinished).
- Refer to Table Runner Layout (Page 2) for F and placement of blocks and borders.

- Arrange blocks in 2 rows. Stitch into rows.
 Sew rows together into table runner center (25-1/4" x 58-1/4" unfinished).
- Stitch Fabric A 3" x 58-1/4" borders to long sides of table runner center. Add Fabric A 3" x 30-1/4" borders to short sides of table runner center.
- 7. The table runner measures approximately 30-1/4" x 63-1/4" (unfinished). Make backing approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste table runner top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric B) and enjoy!!

BLOCK LAYOUT




Table Runner - Make 4 Blocks Throw Quilt - Make 8 Blocks

NOTE ABOUT 5 and 10 KARAT PACKS:

If you have (2) 5 Karat Mini Packs with identical prints as the 10 Karat Mini Pack, select (7) 10" squares and (16) 5" squares for the crowns. Cut each of the (7) 10" squares into (4) 5" squares for a total of (36) 5" squares for the crowns and using the remaining fabrics for the pineapples. Cut squares as directed below.

3. Cut the following for Throw Quilt:

Fabric A - Cut (6) 5" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 5" x 59" and (2) 5" x 58-1/4" borders Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 5" squares, then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles

Fabric B - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric C: (1) 10 Karat Mini pack (pineapple)

Cut (4) 10" squares into (16) 5" squares, then cut in half diagonally for 32 triangles Cut (16) 10" squares into (64) 4-5/8" squares

Fabric D: (2) 5 Karat Mini packs (crown)

Cut (20) 5" squares in half diagonally of for 40 triangles
Trim 16 squares to 4-5/8" square

Fabric E: (2) 5 Karat Mini packs (background)

Cut (32) 5" squares in half diagonally for 64 triangles
Trim 16 squares to 4-5/8" square

Note: Prints in pre-cut packs may vary
from color quilt image.

4. Piecing Order for Throw Quilt:

- Re-label Fabric A 5" triangles as Fabric E.
- Refer to Steps 2-3 for Table Runner instructions to make a total of 8 blocks.
- Refer to Throw Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- Arrange blocks in 2 rows. Stitch into rows.
 Sew rows together into throw quilt center (50" x 58-1/4" unfinished).
- Stitch Fabric A 5" x 58-1/4" borders to long sides of throw quilt center. Add Fabric A 5" x 59" borders to top and bottom of throw quilt center.

- 6. The throw quilt measures approximately 59" x 67-1/4" (unfinished). Make backing approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric B) and enjoy!!



Requires:

1- 10 Karat Mini 4 - 5 Karat Mini Border (A): 1 1/4 yards* Binding (B): 5/8 yard

Backing: 3 7/8 yards

*Border fabric is also used for piecing - should coordinate with background pack color.
