



# Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## **Cutting Instructions**

#### From each of Fabrics A and B, cut:

six 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:

forty-eight 5" squares for the HSTs

#### From Fabric C, cut:

fourteen 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 1-1/2" x 71-1/2" side inner borders two 1-1/2" x 55-1/2" top/bottom inner borders three 1-1/2" x 53-1/2" row sashing strips eight 1-1/2" x 17-1/2" block sashing strips

#### From Fabric D, cut:

twenty-six 1" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 1" x 17-1/2" strips ninety-six 1" x 4-1/2" rectangles forty-eight 2" squares. Mark a diagonal on the back of each square.

#### From Fabric E, cut:

seven 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 4-1/2" x 73-1/2" side outer borders two 4-1/2" x 63-1/2" top/bottom outer borders two 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twelve 5" squares for the HSTs

#### From each of Fabrics F-L, cut:

two 5" x WOF strips. Subcut: twelve 5" squares for the HSTs

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

# Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 5" Fabric A square with a 5" Fabric F square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make twenty-four A/F HSTs.



#### Step 2: Repeat Step 2 to make:



twenty-four A/G HSTs



twenty-four A/I HSTs



twenty-four A/H HSTs



twenty-four B/E HSTs



twenty-four B/J HSTs



twenty-four B/K HSTs



twenty-four B/L HSTs

Assemble the Stitch and Flip Units


**Step 3:** Place a 2" Fabric D square in the Fabric A corner of an A/F HST, right sides together. Note the orientation of the marked diagonal line. Sew on the marked line, then trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press.



**Step 4:** Using six of each HST combination from Step 2, repeat Step 3 to make a total of six stitch and flip units in each of the HST color combinations.



# Assemble the A Blocks



Step 5: Gather:

- three A/F HSTs
- one A/F HST with a Fabric D corner
- three A/I HSTs
- one A/I HST with a Fabric D corner
- three A/G HSTs
- one A/G HST with a Fabric D corner
- three A/H HSTs
- one A/H HST with a Fabric D corner
- eight 1" x 4-1/2" Fabric C strips
- two 1" x 17-1/2" Fabric D strips

Arrange as shown, following the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 6: Sew a 1" x 4-1/2" Fabric D strip between each pair of HSTs. Press toward the strip.

**Step 7:** Sew the HST units together to form the rows. Press the seams open or to one side.

**Step 8:** Sew the rows together, sewing the 1" x 17-1/2" Fabric D strips between Rows 1/2 and Rows 3/4.

The finished A Block should measure 17-1/2" square. Make six A Blocks.



# Assemble the B Blocks

**Step 9:** Using the process in Steps 5-8, and the fabrics shown in the B Block diagram, make six B Blocks, each measuring 17-1/2" square.

### Assemble the Quilt



**Step 10:** Arrange the A and B Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make four block rows.

**Step 11:** Sew the row sashing and block rows together. Press seams open or to the sashing.

**Step 12:** Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 13:** Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
