
# Essentials Dotsy



Crossroads Quilt: 60" x 80"



# Crossroads featruing Essentials Dotsy Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

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All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 5-1/2" squares and (6) 3" squares Cut (3) 3" strips, subcut (42) 3" squares

Fabrics B, D, F, G, H, I, and J

From each fabric:

Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut

(1) 5-1/2" square and (1) 3" square

Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (28) 3" squares

Fabric C - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut

(1) 5-1/2" square and (1) 3" squares

Cut (2) 3" strip, subcut (28) 3" squares

Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabrics E - Cut (3) 3" strips, subcut (38) 3" squares

Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (36) 1-3/4" squares

Fabric K - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (5) 5-1/2" squares

Cut (4) 3" strips, subcut (48) 3" squares

Fabric L - Cut (3) 3" strips, subcut (34) 3" squares

Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (36) 1-3/4" squares

Fabric M - Cut (7) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3"x 75-1/2" and (2) 3"x 60-1/2" borders

Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (24) 3"x 5-1/2" pieces

Fabrics N and O - From each fabric: Cut (6) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (36) 5-1/2" squares and (12) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

#### 2. Piecing Order:

 Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each of the 1-3/4" and 3" squares.  Place Fabrics A and G 3" squares and a Fabric L 1-3/4" square as shown on a Fabric N 5-1/2" square. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out to complete Unit 1a (5-1/2" square unfinished).







Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

In the same manner, use fabrics indicated to make 1 each Units 1b, 2a, and 2b.







4. Arrange Units 1a, 1b, 2a, and 2b in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 1a** (10-1/2" square unfinished).



5. Repeat Steps 2-4 to make

1 each **Blocks 1b-1r** with the fabrics indicated for each block in Quilt Layout (Page 3).

6. Stitch 1 each Fabrics B and C 3" squares together. Stitch to left side of a Fabric D 5-1/2" square as shown. Sew Fabrics J and H 3" squares together. Stitch to the right side of the Fabric D square. Arrange




Block 2a - Make 1

Fabrics E, I, G, and L 3" squares in a row on top and Fabrics L, D, F, and E 3" squares on bottom of the block. Sew squares into rows. Sew to top and bottom of block to complete Block 2a (10-1/2" square unfinished).

7. In the same manner, make 1 each **Blocks**2b, 2e, 2f, 2g, 2h, 2i and 2j, 5 **Block** 2c, and 4 **Block** 2d. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for the fabric for the 5-1/2" square. Fabrics for 3" squares remain the same for all blocks.


8. Place a Fabric K 3" square on a Fabric O 3" x 5-1/2" piece as shown. Place a Fabric A 3" square on a Fabric N 3" x 5-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Sew



Block 3 - Make 12

the pieces together as shown. Make a total of 12 Block 3 (2-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished).

9. Place **Fabric D** 3" squares on **Fabric M** 3" x 5-1/2" pieces as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Sew the pieces together as shown. Make a total of



2 Block 4a (2-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished).

10. In the same manner, make 1 each Blocks 4d, 4e, 4g and 4h and 2 each Block 4b, 4c, and 4f. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for the fabric for the 3" squares. Fabrics for 3" x 5-1/2" pieces are Fabric M for all blocks.


Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

- Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for placement and arrangement of squares, blocks and border.
- 12. Arrange (4) 3" Fabric E squares and blocks in 9 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (55-1/2" x 75-1/2" unfinished).
- 13. Sew **Fabric M** 3" x 75-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric M** 3" x 60-1/2" borders to top and bottom.
- 14. The quilt measures approximately 60-1/2" x 80-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric P**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric C) and enjoy!!
