

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 44" wide.

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 44" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A (if not using precuts), cut:

thirty-six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: six-hundred four 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric B (if not using precuts), cut:

thirty-two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: five-hundred twenty-six 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric C-F, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: eight 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric G-I, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: ten 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric J and K, cut:


one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: eleven 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric L and M, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: thirteen 2-1/2" squares

From the binding fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips




Assemble the A Blocks

Gather fifteen Fabric A squares, thirteen Fabric B squares and eight Fabric C squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in six rows of six blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open.

Repeat to make a total of eight A Blocks, using Fabrics D-F and J-M in place of Fabric C in the above directions.


Assemble the B Blocks



Gather seven Fabric A squares, six Fabric B squares and five Fabric I squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in six rows of three blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open.

Repeat to make a second B Block with Fabric I. Repeat, again, to make one additional block each, using Fabrics G, H, I, L and M in place of Fabric I in the above directions. There are a total of six B Blocks.


Assemble the C Blocks



Gather ten Fabric A squares, nine Fabric B squares and five Fabric H squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in six rows of four blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open.


Repeat to make a second C Block with Fabric G in place of Fabric H in the above directions. There are a total of two C Blocks.

Assemble the D Block



Gather three Fabric A squares, three Fabric B squares and three Fabric J squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in three rows of three blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered row. Press row seams open.

Assemble the E Block




Gather three Fabric A squares, three Fabric B squares and three Fabric K squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in three rows of three blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered row. Press row seams open.

Assemble the F Block


Gather two Fabric A squares and one Fabric B square. Arrange and sew together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Press seams open. Set aside for use in the bottom row of the quilt.

Assemble the G Blocks




Gather sixteen Fabric A squares and twelve Fabric B squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in seven rows of four blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open. Repeat to make four G Blocks.

Assemble the H Blocks




Gather twenty-four Fabric A squares and eighteen Fabric B squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in seven rows of six blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open. Repeat to make six H Blocks.

Assemble the I Blocks




Gather nineteen Fabric A squares and sixteen Fabric B squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in seven rows of five blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open. Repeat to make two I Blocks.

Assemble the J Blocks




Gather ten Fabric A squares and ten Fabric B squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in five rows of four blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open. Repeat to make two J Blocks.

Assemble the K Blocks




Gather sixteen Fabric A squares and fourteen Fabric B squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in five rows of six blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open. Repeat to make three K Blocks.

Assemble the L Block




Gather thirteen Fabric A squares and twelve Fabric B squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in five rows of five blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open. There is one L Block.

Assemble the M Block




Gather eleven Fabric A squares and thirteen Fabric B squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in six rows of four blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open. There is one M Block.

Assemble the N Blocks



Gather seventeen Fabric A squares and nineteen Fabric B squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in six rows of six blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open. Repeat to make four N Blocks.


Assemble the O Block



Gather eight Fabric A squares and ten Fabric B squares. Arrange together as illustrated in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together in six rows of three blocks. Press square seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Press row seams open. There is one O Block.

Assemble the Quilt

Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, lay out blocks A-O. Sew together in seven rows, pinning to help match the seams. Press block and row seams open.



Your quilt top is now complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
