Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.


All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvege to selvege, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Mini Quilt:


NOTE: Name one pack of 5" squares **Fabric A** and sort into 8 lightest (**Fabric A-l**), 8 darkest (**Fabric A-d**), and the remaining 8 medium squares (**Fabric A-m**).

Fabric A-l - Cut (8) 5" squares in half  diagonally once for a total of 16 triangles


Fabric A-m - Trim (8) 5" squares to 4-5/8" squares

Fabric A-d - Cut (8) 5" squares in half  diagonally once for a total of 16 triangles


NOTE: Name one pack of 5" squares **Fabric B** and sort into 8 lightest (**Fabric B-l**), 8 darkest (**Fabric B-d**), and the remaining 8 medium squares (**Fabric B-m**).

Fabric B-l - Cut (8) 5" squares in half  diagonally once for a total of 16 triangles


Fabric B-m - Trim (8) 5" squares to 4-5/8" squares

Fabric B-d - Cut (8) 5" squares in half  diagonally once for a total of 16 triangles

NOTE: Name one pack of 5" squares **Fabric C** and sort into 8 lightest (**Fabric C-l**), 8 darkest (**Fabric C-d**), and the remaining 8 medium squares (**Fabric C-m**).

Fabric C-l - Cut (8) 5" squares in half  diagonally once for a total of 16 triangles

Fabric C-m - Trim (8) 5" squares to 4-5/8" squares

Fabric C-d - Cut (8) 5" squares in half  diagonally once for a total of 16 triangles

1st Border - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut

(2) 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" borders

Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 37-5/8" borders

2nd Border - Cut (3) 5-1/2" strips, sewn

together end to end and cut into

(2) 5-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders.

Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut

(2) 4-1/2" x 41-5/8" borders.

2. Piecing Order for Mini Quilt:

1. Randomly select an **A-l** triangle and a **C-d** triangle, and sew long edges together. Repeat to make 16 Unit 1 (4-5/8" square unfinished).

2. Randomly select a **B-l** triangle and an **A-d** triangle, and sew long edges together. Repeat to make 16 Unit 2.

3. Randomly select a **C-l** triangle and a **B-d** triangle, and sew long edges together. Repeat to make 16 Unit 3.

4. Refer to Mini Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of units and borders.

5. Arrange units in 9 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (33-1/2" x 37-5/8" unfinished).

6. Sew 2" x 37-5/8" **1st Borders** to right and left sides of quilt center. Stitch 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" **1st Borders** to top and bottom of quilt center.

7. Sew 4-1/2" x 41-5/8" **2nd Borders** to right and left sides of quilt center. Stitch 5-1/2" x 44-1/2" **2nd Borders** to top and bottom of quilt center.

8. The quilt measures approximately 44-1/2 x 51-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing approximately 8" larger than the top.

9. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Same as **1st Border**) and enjoy!!

3. Cut the following for Queen Quilt:

NOTE: Name one pack of 10" squares **Fabric A** and sort into 8 lightest (**Fabric A-l**), 8 darkest (**Fabric A-d**), and the remaining 8 medium squares (**Fabric A-m**).

Fabric A-l - Set aside (8) 10" squares

Fabric A-m - Cut (4) 4-5/8" squares from each of the 10" squares for 32 squares

Fabric A-d - Set aside (8) 10" squares

Shading of diagrams
may vary depending on fabrics used.

Lightning

NOTE: Name one pack of 10" squares **Fabric B** and sort into 8 lightest (**Fabric B-l**), 8 darkest (**Fabric B-d**), and the remaining 8 medium squares (**Fabric B-m**).

Fabric B-l - Set aside (8) 10" squares

Fabric B-m - Cut (4) 4-5/8" squares from each of the 10" squares for 32 squares

Fabric B-d - Set aside (8) 10" squares

NOTE: Name one pack of 10" squares **Fabric C** and sort into 8 lightest (**Fabric C-l**), 8 darkest (**Fabric C-d**), and the remaining 8 medium squares (**Fabric C-m**).

Fabric C-l - Set aside (8) 10" squares

Fabric C-m - Cut (4) 4-5/8" squares from each of the 10" squares for 32 squares

Fabric C-d - Set aside (8) 10" squares

1st Border - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 70" and (2) 2-1/2" x 74-3/4" borders

2nd Border - Cut (8) 5-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 5-1/2" x 80-1/2" and (2) 5-1/2" x 78-3/4" borders

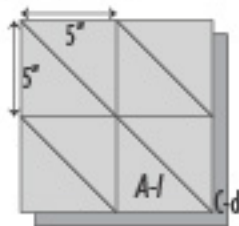
Binding - Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

ALTERNATE METHOD FOR PIECING UNITS:

Units for this quilt are pieced with a drawn grid. To use triangles instead, cut each set-aside square into (4) 5" squares, then cut each 5" square in half diagonally once for a total of 64 triangles each **Fabrics A-l, A-d, B-l, B-d, C-l** and **C-d**. Piece triangles together to make 64 each Units 1-3.

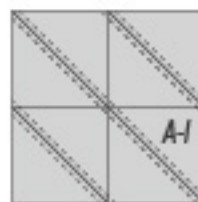
4. Piecing Order for Queen Quilt:

1. Select 1 each **Fabrics A-l** and **C-d** 10" square. On wrong side of the **A-l** fabric, draw a vertical and horizontal line 5" from corners. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner. Draw 2 short diagonal lines parallel to center diagonal line as shown. Place marked **A-l** square centered over the **C-d** square.

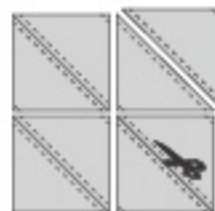


Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of each of the diagonal lines as shown.



3. Carefully cut along vertical, horizontal, and all diagonal lines. Pick stitches from corners as needed.



Press triangles open for 8 Unit 1. Make a total of 64 Unit 1 (4-5/8" square unfinished).

4. Repeat Steps 1-3 to make 64 each Units 2 and 3 with the fabrics indicated.

5. Refer to Queen Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of units, squares, and borders.

6. Arrange units and squares in 18 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (66-1/2" x 74-3/4" unfinished).

7. Sew 2-1/2" x 74-3/4" **1st Borders** to right and left sides of quilt center. Stitch 2-1/2" x 70-1/2" **1st Borders** to top and bottom of quilt center.

8. Sew 5-1/2" x 78-3/4" **2nd Borders** to right and left sides of quilt center. Stitch 5-1/2" x 80-1/2" **2nd Borders** to top and bottom of quilt center.

9. The quilt measures approximately 80-1/2" x 88-3/4" (unfinished). Make backing approximately 8" larger than the top.

10. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding and enjoy!!

5. Cut the following for Throw & Runner Set:

Follow cutting instructions for Queen Quilt using 10" square packs, **Fabrics A, B, and C**.

Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

Lightning

1st Border (Includes runner binding)

Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, runner binding

Cut (6) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 66-1/2" and (2) 1-3/4" x 52-1/2" throw borders

2nd Border - Cut (7) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together

end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 69" and (2) 3-1/2" x 58-1/2" throw borders

Binding (Includes runner border)

Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips, throw binding

Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 74-5/8" and (2) 2-1/2" x 21-1/8" runner borders

7. Sew 2-1/2" x 21-1/8" **1st Borders** (cut from fabric for Throw binding) to short ends of runner center. Stitch 2-1/2" x 74-5/8" **1st Borders** (cut from fabric for Throw binding) to top and bottom.

8. The throw measures approximately 58-1/2 x 75" (unfinished). The runner measures approximately 25" x 74-1/2" (unfinished). Make backings approximately 8" larger than the tops.

9. For throw and runner, layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding to each and enjoy!!

6. Piecing Order for Throw & Runner Set:

1. Referring to Steps 1-4 in Piecing Order for Queen Quilt, make 64 each Units 1-3.

2. Refer to Throw Quilt Layout (Page 5) and Runner Layout (Page 5) for arrangement and placement of units, squares, and borders.

3. For Throw, arrange units and squares in 16 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete throw center (50" x 66-1/2" unfinished).

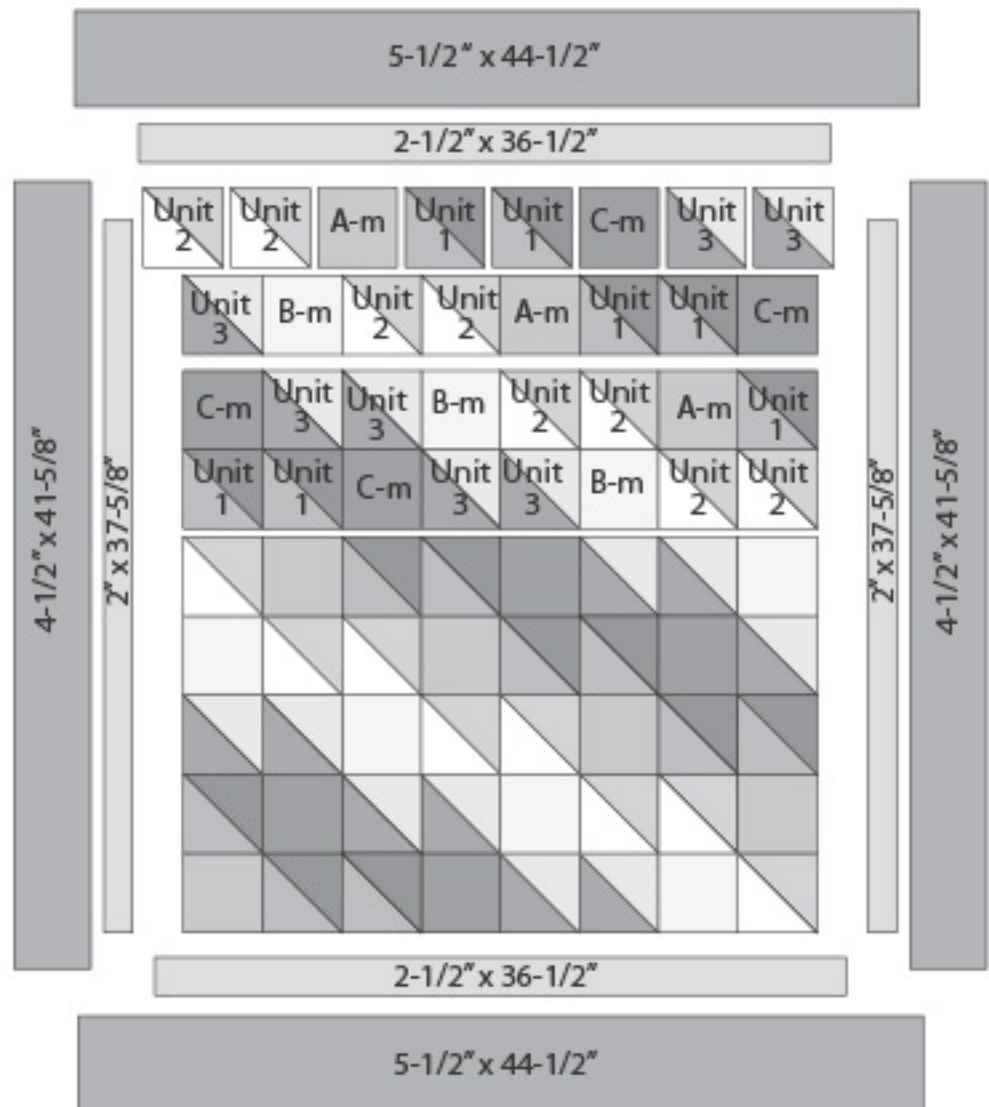
4. Sew 1-3/4" x 66-1/2" **1st Borders** to right and left sides of throw center. Stitch 1-3/4" x 52-1/2" **1st Borders** to top and bottom.

5. Sew 3-1/2" x 69" **2nd Borders** to right and left sides of throw. Stitch 3-1/2" x 58-1/2" **2nd Borders** to top and bottom.

6. For runner, arrange units and squares in 5 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete runner center (21-1/8" x 70-1/2" unfinished). (Not all units and medium squares will be used.)

Border measurements are the cut size.



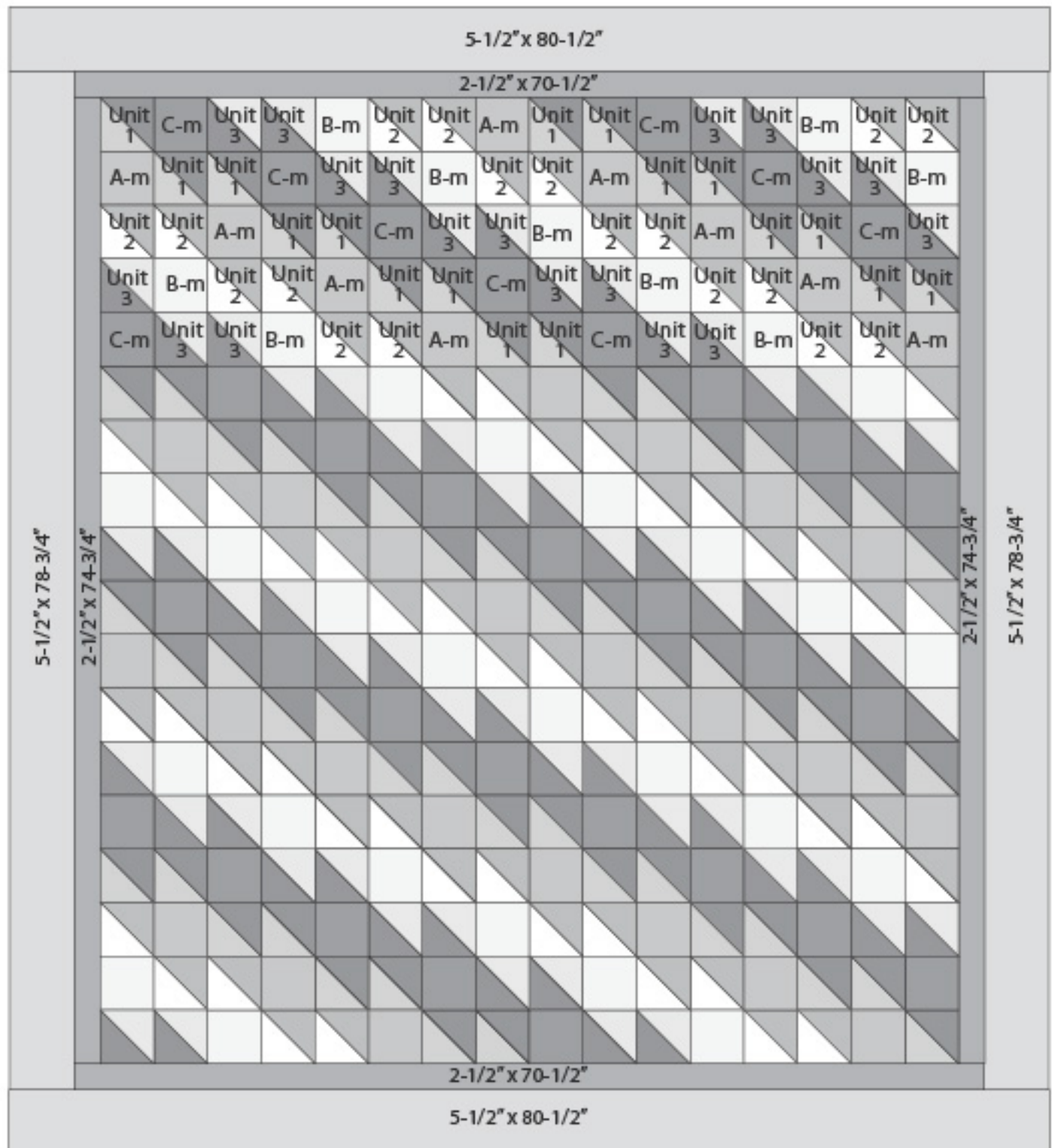

Shading of Quilt Layouts may vary depending on fabrics used.

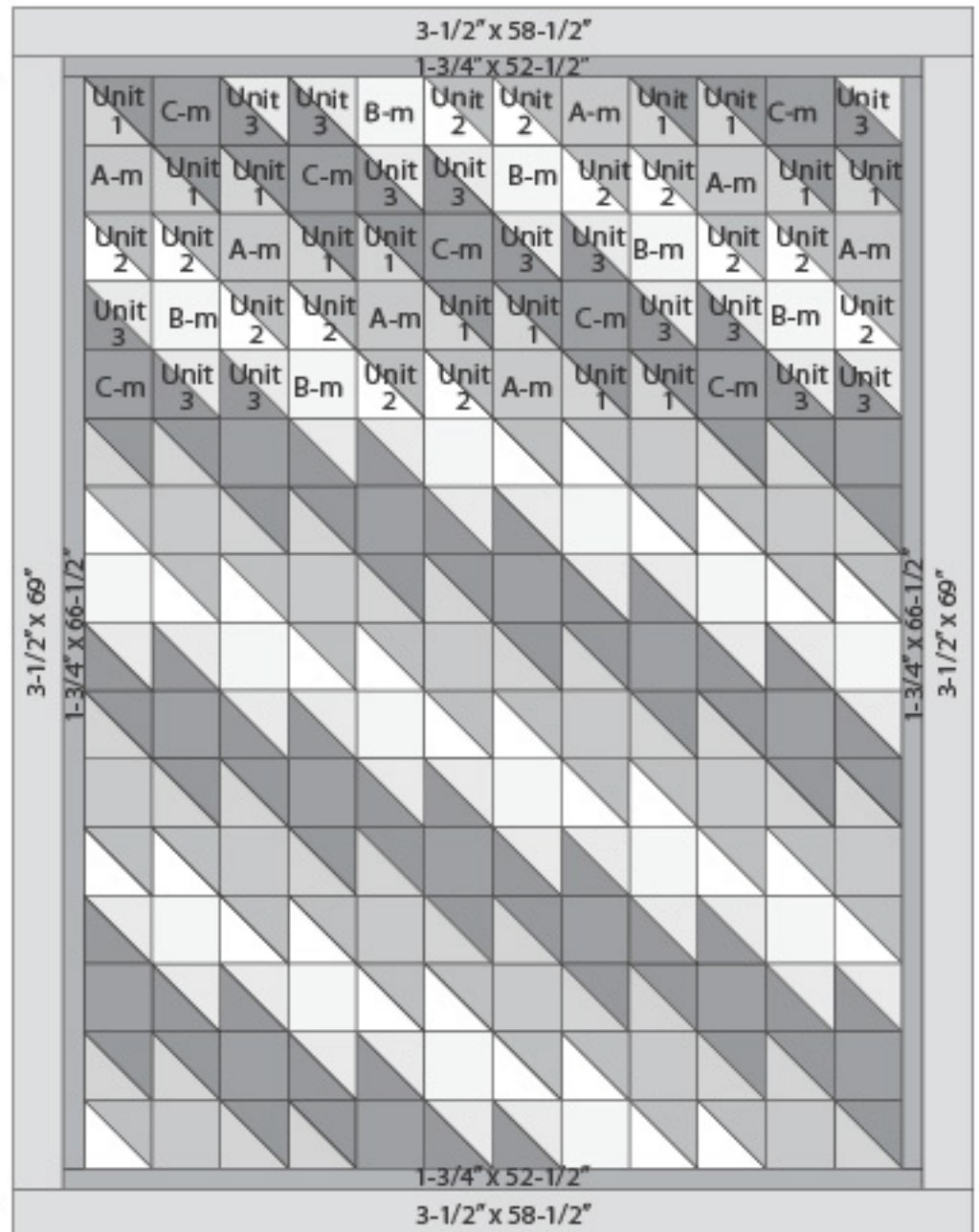
