Pocket Exterior 1/3 yd. Allover Print or 2/3 yd. Vertical Striped

Lining & Faux binding for Bag & Pocket 7/8 yard

Handles

1/2 yard

C & D Combined - 1 1/3 yards

ALSO Requires: 7/8 yd. Flannel or Fusible Fleece 1/4 yd. Fusible Interfacing



Tote Bag #1 with Wrap-Around Pockets

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 15-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 15-1/2" x 19" tote pieces

Fabric B (all-over print) - Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 6-1/2" x 19" pocket pieces

Fabric B (stripe print) - Cut 2 identical stripes the length of fabric, 6-1/2" to 9" wide by 19" long pocket pieces

Fabric C - Cut (1) 16-3/4" strip, subcut (2) 16-3/4" x 19" pieces tote lining Cut (1) 10-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 10-1/4" x 19" pieces pocket lining

Fabric D - Cut (2) 6" handle strips


Fusible Fleece - Cut (1) 15-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 15-1/2" x 19" pieces Cut (1) 9" strip, subcut (2) 9" x 19" pieces

Interfacing - Cut (4) 1-3/4" strips


NOTES: Backstitch to secure ends of stitching lines. Seam allowances are 1/2" unless stated otherwise. Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints when used. Dotted diagrams indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Piecing Order:


 Fuse 15-1/2" x 19" fusible fleece to wrong side of each Fabric A 15-1/2" x 19" piece.



2. Trim 9" x 19" fusible fleece pieces to same size of Fabric B pieces (if needed). Fuse to wrong side of Fabric B pieces.



Align long edge of a Fabric C 10-1/4" x 19" piece with top of a Fabric B piece. right sides together. Stitch together with 1/2" seam. Make 2.



Press seam allowance to Fabric C. Wrap

Fabric C over the seam allowance so it is wrong sides together with the Fabric B piece. About 1/2" Fabric C will show above



Fabric B side. Trim extra Fabric C as needed on bottom. "Stitch in the ditch" under seam line. Finish bottom edge by serging or sewing with a zigzag stitch. On Fabric C, draw a line 1/2" from the bottom. Repeat to make a second Pocket Section.

In the same manner as Step 3, align long edge of a Fabric C 15-1/2" x 19" piece with top of a Fabric A piece. Stitch together with 1/2" seam.

Press seam allowance to Fabric C. Wrap

Fabric C over the seam allowance so it is wrong sides together with the




Make 2 Bag Sections

Fabric A piece. About 1/2" Fabric C will show above Fabric A. "Stitch in the ditch" along seam line. Trim extra Fabric C as needed on bottom. Repeat to make a second Bag Section.


7. Place a Bag Section with Fabric A side up on a flat work surface. Align a Pocket Section Fabric B side down on Fabric A with top of Pocket Section towards the bottom of Bag Section as shown in diagram on next page. The sections should overlap by 4". Pin all layers together along the marked line 1/2" from bottom of Fabric C. Repeat to make a second Bag/Pocket Section.

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


8. Fold a **Fabric D** 6" strip in half lengthwise so it is 3" wide. Open then fold raw long raw edges to center fold and press again for a total of 3 equally.

of 3 equally spaced fold lines.




9. Fuse 1-1/4" interfacing strips centered on the wrong side of **Fabric D** strip as shown.



10. Refold so **Fabric D** strip is 1-1/2" wide.
Topstitch 1/16" to 1/8" from each long edge to finish handle.

11. Repeat Steps 8-10 to make a second handle.

12. Pin a handle (without twisting) to a Bag/
Pocket Section 6"
from right and left edges and overlapping the line marked on Fabric C by 1/2" as shown.
Stitch along marked line through all layers. Stitch 1/4" from handle edge, along outside of the handle from seam




line to top of Bag Section around the loose handle and back down the Bag Section. Repeat on inside edge of handle. Add second handle to remaining Bag/Pocket Section. 13. Press each pocket up,
over the handles and press.
Sew center pocket
divisions by sewing
through all layers
centered over
handles. Stitching
lines can be moved
to make the center
pockets narrower
or wider as desired.

Repeat on the other Bag/Pocket Section.

 Serge, or stitch with zigzag, over all side and bottom raw edges of both sections.

15. Align Bag/Pocket Sections, pocket sides in, with top and side edges aligned. Sew together on both sides and bottom with 1/2" seam. Press seams open.




bottom of pocket seams

16. Align side and bottom seams on 1 bottom corner of bag to create a "V" shape.
Viewing it from the bottom seam, sew across the corner just under the seams for pocket bottoms

the seams for pocket bottoms to form gusset. Repeat on other bottom corner.

17. Turn bag right side out.
Lay gusset corners on
bottom of bag and tack
in place. Tack
edges of side seam
allowances to sides of
bag. Finished bag is
approximately
12" wide x 12" tall x 6" deep.
