### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

fifteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two hundred forty 2-1/2" squares. On the back of each square, mark a line along the diagonal. four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 1-1/2" x 45-1/2" side inner borders two 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

#### From Fabric B, cut:

five 3" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 3" x 43-1/2" side outer borders two 3" x 47-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

#### From the Ten Square pack:

Pull one square each from Fabrics B, C, D, Q, R, and S, and all squares of Fabrics T, U, V, and W. Set these aside for another project.

From the remaining squares, cut:


four 5" squares from each 10" square, for a total of one hundred twenty squares.

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:


six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

#### Assemble the Blocks

**Step 1:** Place a 2-1/2" Fabric A square in the upper right corner of a 5" Fabric B-S square, right sides together. Note the orientation of the marked diagonal line. Sew on the marked line, then trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press. Repeat on the lower left corner with another 2-1/2" Fabric A square. Repeat to make a total of one hundred twenty Blocks.



## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 2:** Arrange the blocks into twelve rows of ten blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

**Step 3:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 4:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

**Step 5:** Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 6:** Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
