

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A and G, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eighteen 3" squares

From each of Fabrics B and I, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:
six 3" squares

From Fabric C, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-four 3" squares
five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:
two 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" side middle borders
two 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" top/bottom middle borders

From each of Fabrics D and F, cut:

three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty 3" squares

From Fabric E, cut:

three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-six 3" squares

From Fabric H, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:
twelve 3" squares

From Fabric J, cut:

ten 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:
two 3-1/2" x 56-1/2" side outer borders
two 3-1/2" x 54-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
two 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" side inner borders
two 3-1/2" x 46-1/2" top/bottom inner borders
thirteen 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one-hundred and eighty 3" squares
eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one-hundred and twenty 2-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 3" Fabric A square with a 3" Fabric J square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make thirty-six A/J HSTs.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:

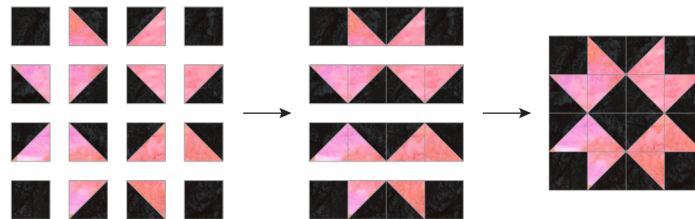

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 3: Select twelve matching HSTs and four 2-1/2" Fabric J squares. Arrange the squares and HSTs in four rows of four to form a star as shown. Sew the squares and HSTs together to form rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press again.



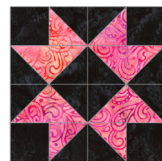
Step 4: Repeat Step 3 to make:



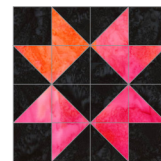

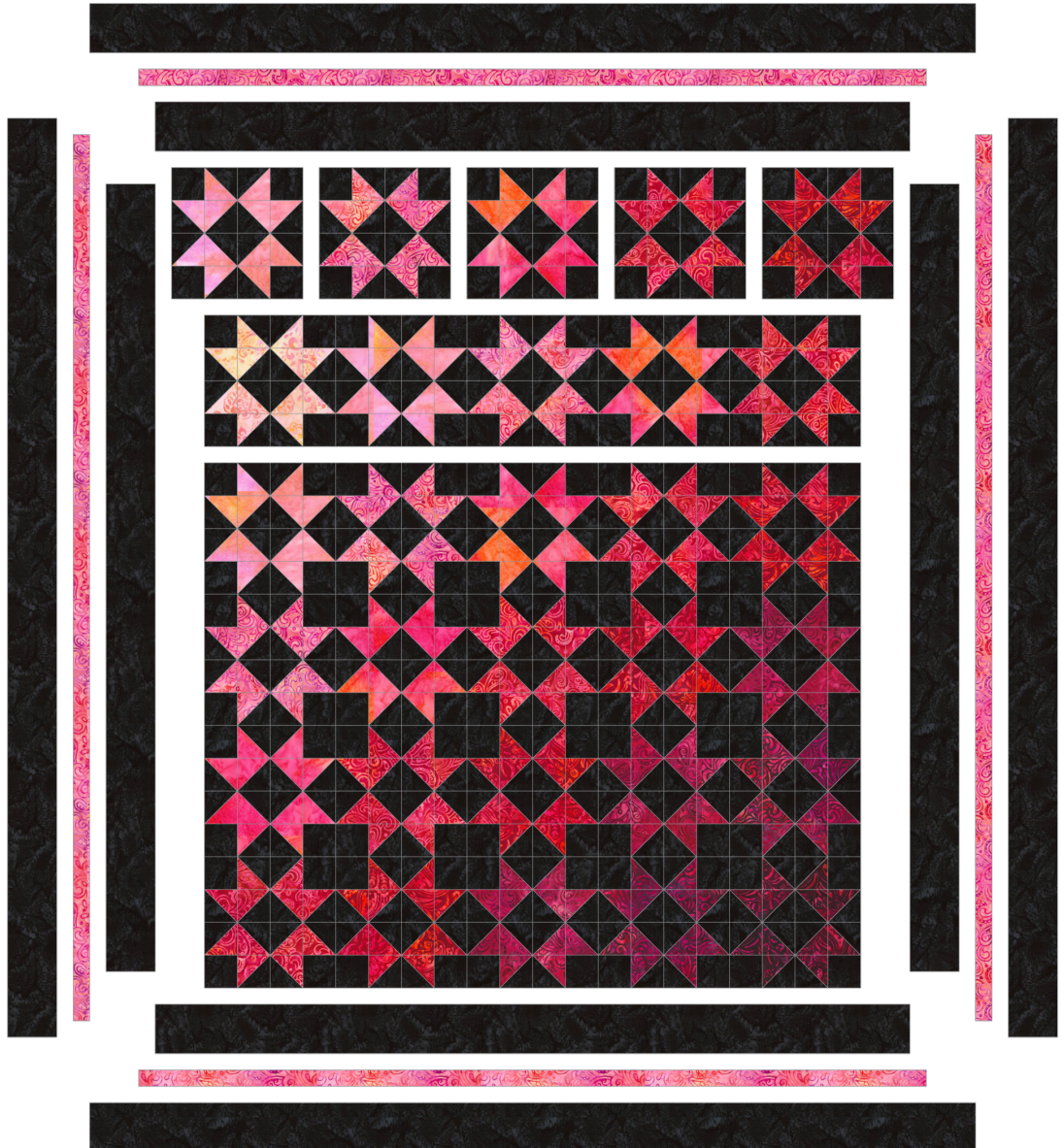
Assemble the Quilt

Step 5: Arrange the blocks into six rows of five blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 6: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.

Step 7: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 8: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.



Step 9: Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 10: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
