## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A-C, cut:
three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: nine 3-1/2" $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

From Fabric D, cut:
eight 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 4-1/2" x 83-1/2" side outer borders two 4-1/2" x 73-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics E and F, cut:
four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 3-1/2" $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

From each of Fabrics $\mathbf{G}$ and H , cut:
four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirteen 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

## From Fabric I, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirteen 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles
seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 1-1/2" $\times 82-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side inner borders
two 1-1/2" x 63-1/2" top/bottom inner borders
From each of Fabrics J-L, cut:
four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: fourteen 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics M-O, cut:
three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: eleven 3-1/2" $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Step 1: Sew a Fabric A, Fabric B and Fabric C rectangle together, in that order, along the longest edge. Press. Repeat to make nine ABC Blocks.

Step 2: Sew a Fabric D, Fabric E and Fabric F rectangle together, in that order, along the longest edge. Press. Repeat to make sixteen DEF Blocks.

Step 3: Sew a Fabric G, Fabric H and Fabric I rectangle together, in that order, along the longest edge. Press. Repeat to make thirteen GHI Blocks.

Step 4: Sew a Fabric J, Fabric K and Fabric L rectangle together, in that order, along the longest edge. Press. Repeat to make fourteen JKL Blocks.

Step 5: Sew a Fabric $M$, Fabric $N$ and Fabric O rectangle together, in that order, along the longest edge. Press. Repeat to make eleven MNO Blocks.



Step 7: Arrange the blocks into nine rows of seven blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 9: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 10: Sew the Fabric I top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric I side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 11: Sew the Fabric D side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric D top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
